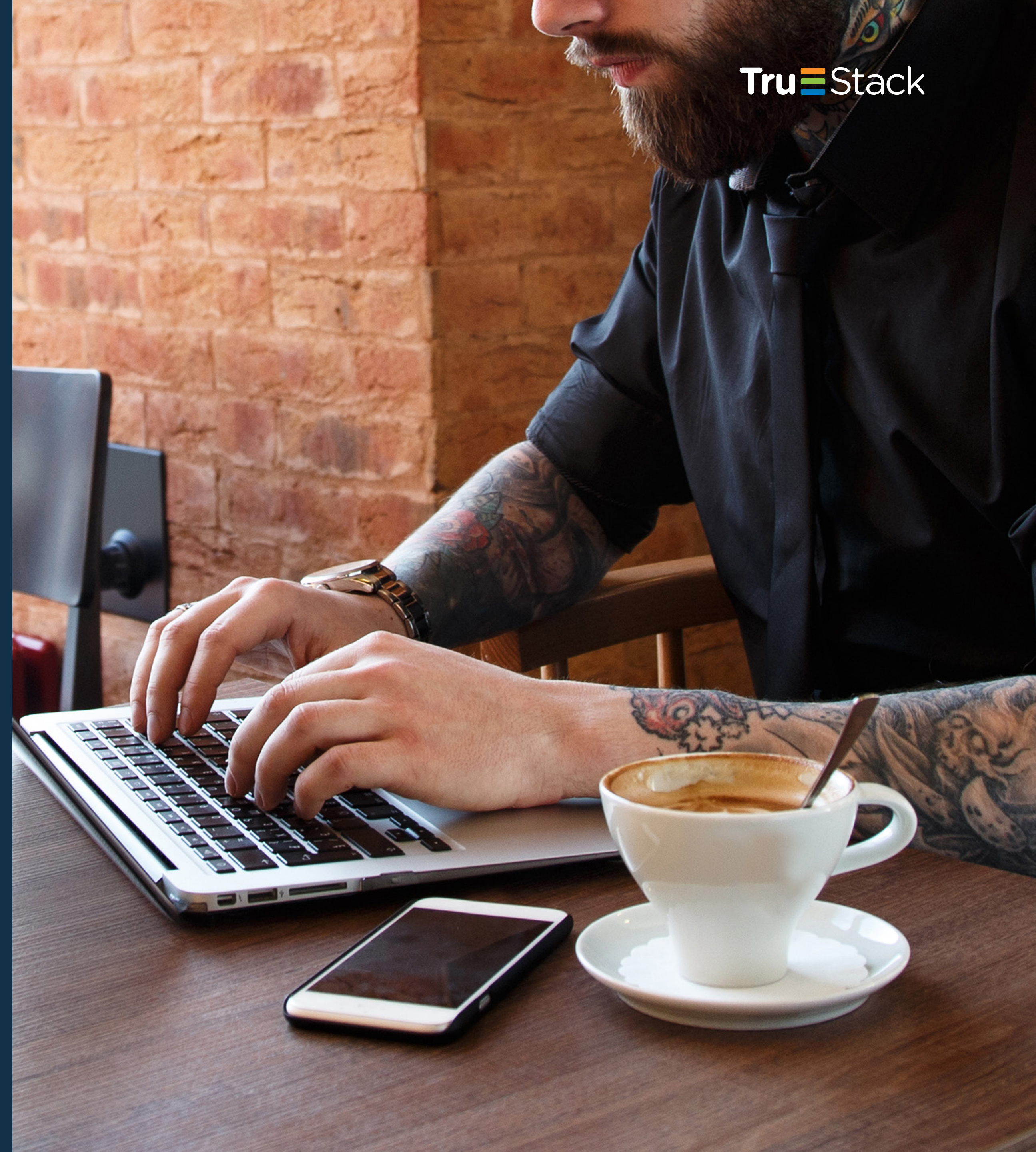


The way we work today has changed
